NOVEMBER

The annual International Festival celebrated the countries and cultures that make up our school community. The festival offered delicious food, memorabilia, cultural activities, and conversations about cultural heritage.



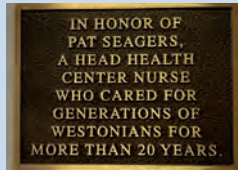
SEPTEMBER

40 clubs represented student interests in everything from visual and literary arts to politics and social activism to sports and hobbies to service and philanthropy, and myriad topics in between at the annual Club Fair.



OCTOBER

Former Health Center Head Nurse, Pat Seagers, was joined by friends and family on campus when a plaque was dedicated and installed in her honor in the waiting room of the Health Center.



Families and their four-legged friends strolled the campus paths that were replete with doggie cafes and treat stations at the annual Campus Dog Walk.



Sophomores engaged in a day of service, volunteering at a number of local non-profits including Habitat for Humanity, The Chester County Food Bank, delivering food donations to City Team in Chester, and the Coatesville Pro-Bono Counseling Center.

Lower School art students designed, created, and animated masks from a spectrum of inspiration, from tiny bugs to imaginary aliens to celebrate the diversity of our planet and the creativity within each of us.



DECEMBER

Alums and members of the community participated in the annual Alums/Community Basketball Game.

Fifth graders worked on Peacemaker Projects in which they researched a Nobel Peace Prize winner and designed a poster to show various aspects of this peacemaker's life and work.



MARCH

Performers, behind-the-scenes students, and Director of Theater Arts, Alex Ates, presented the world-premiere Middle School musical, *Ellsworth*, about a brilliant economics professor (who happens to be a dog) and celebrating what makes us unique.

This year's African dance performance marked the 20th anniversary of African dance and the school's special partnership with Jeannine Osayande and the Dunya Performing Arts Company. Third graders learned the movements and storytelling of African dances and Capoeira, and their origins, symbolism, and impact.

The World Languages Department held its first annual National World Languages Week to promote language acquisition, build cultural competency, provide students a platform to celebrate their success, and help students envision their future career paths where they can apply their language skills and cultural knowledge.



MAY

Alums Weekend 2022 was a wonderful opportunity to rediscover what makes Westtown special for alums. We were thrilled to welcome over 700 alums and guests back to campus for the first time since 2019 for a weekend full of events.

As part of their Think, Care, Act Fair, the seventh grade filled the Uptown Lounge (the "Old Gym" above the Dining Room) with trifold and shared experiences with their families, teachers, and sixth and eighth grade peers. Students identified their strengths, affinities, interests, and talents and connected them into a service project that helps others by putting passions and skills to good use.

Kaylene Smikle '22, recipient of Gatorade's Player of the Year and Play it Forward Spotlight Grants, paid it forward when she donated her \$11,000 award money back to the girls basketball team. Kaylene shared, "In a short time, the program has prepared me for success at the college level, on and off the court. This is an up and coming program that will flourish for many years to come. I am proud to call Westtown my home away from home."

The Middle and Upper School Dance Recital showcased the amazing talents of our dance program students.



JANUARY

Talented students in our Upper School Instrumental Program were accepted to the highly competitive PA Music Educators Association District 12 Honors Ensembles and became eligible for Region 6 Festivals and All-State.

FEBRUARY

Our girls varsity and boys varsity basketball teams won the 2022 Friends School League and the PAISAA State Championships.



APRIL

In response to the invasion of Ukraine, a third grade service project raised \$4,500 for Save the Children.

Common Market, a nonprofit regional wholesale food distributor in Philadelphia, presented Westtown with a Certificate of Support, recognizing the school's efforts to purchase sustainably farmed local food.

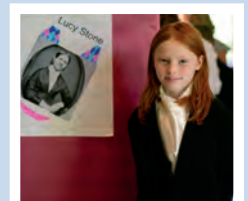


JUNE

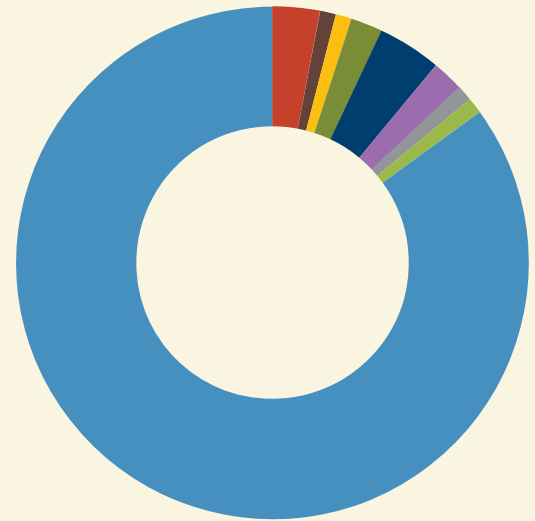
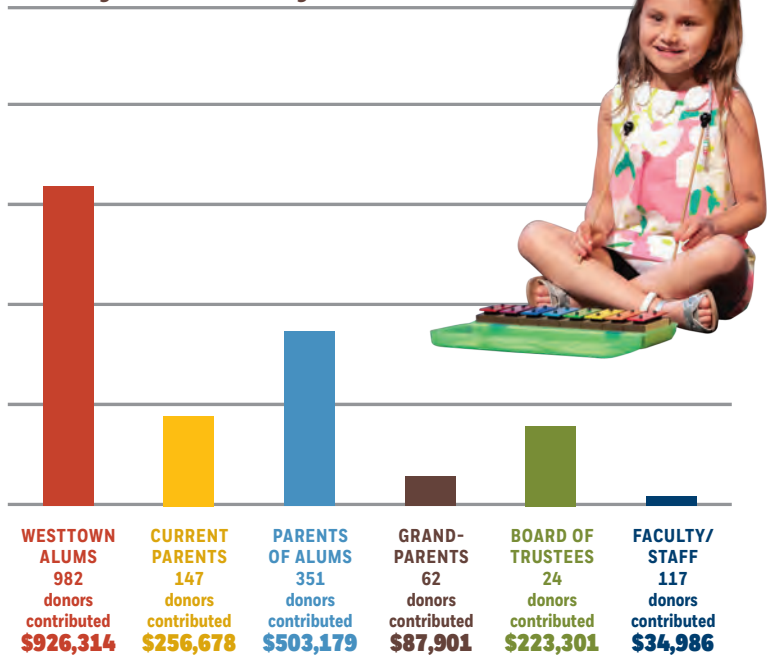

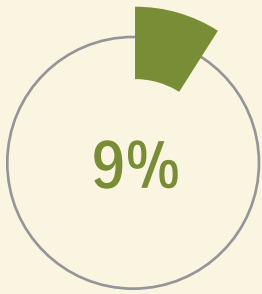
Gifts by Constituency



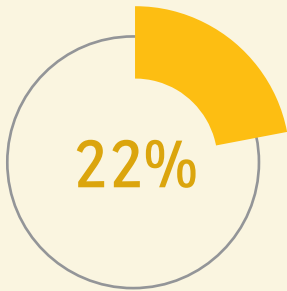

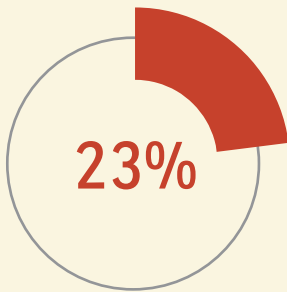




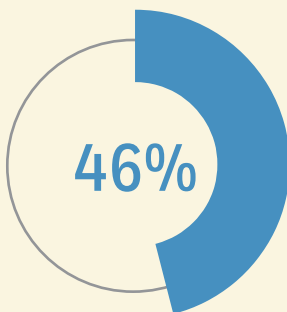

A LIFE WELL LIVED

Adah Davis '38 Leaves a Lasting Legacy

ADAH DAVIS '38 was a very private person who devoted her life to helping others. Upon meeting her, you might think she was quiet and unassuming, but, oh, how wrong you would be! Adah was a force to be reckoned with.

Adah grew up near Erie, Pennsylvania. She was a beloved niece to her aunt, who was the private nurse of William Bell, Class of 1897. Adah often traveled with her aunt and Mr. Bell, and she frequently served as his secretary. It was Mr. Bell who spoke with Adah about attending his alma mater, Westtown School, where he had served on the General Committee and donated funds to build the Stadium Tennis Courts.

Adah attended Westtown for two years, graduating in 1938. She then enrolled at Wellesley College and, after graduating, joined the Army and served in the Philippines as a nurse during World War II. After the war, Adah earned master's degrees from Yale University in public health in 1945 and from Columbia County Teachers College in Ohio in 1950. She continued to work in public health in Connecticut, Michigan, New York, and Pennsylvania, often training other nurses. Adah loved her work.

Upon retirement, Adah moved to the Crosslands community in Kennett Square, Pennsylvania. It was close to Westtown and many other Westonians lived there, including a few classmates. She delighted in coming to campus to attend musicals and the holiday concert with Susan Temple '68 (former Associate Head of School) and me, and lunches with former Head of School John Baird.



John recalls, "It was always a good day when Adah came to Westtown. She wanted to know, in detail, about Westtown today. She had a keen interest in our current and future plans and priorities and what they would mean for students. She delighted in seeing student activities around campus; her face beamed while watching a play, a concert, or a demonstration in the Science Center. In one conversation, Adah reflected that despite all the changes that had happened since her time at Westtown, its essential character was the same. For her, the evidence of that was in the



caring, respectful relationships between the faculty and the students. The teachers, she said, had always conveyed the feeling that the world is going to survive, and that Westtown students were going to play an important part. I can't imagine a more meaningful or hopeful confirmation of the school, the teachers, its students and graduates."

I had the privilege of getting to know Adah on a deeper level. We spoke regularly on the phone, went out for lunch every year on her birthday, walked together at Longwood Gardens or the Crosslands' garden, and enjoyed

afternoon tea and cookies or her homemade bean soup.

In our discussions, Adah asked probing questions about the school. She was keenly interested in the physical plant, faculty salaries, and financial aid. She gave generously every year to the Westtown Fund, in addition to substantial gifts to the Bicentennial Fund, the Science Center renovation, and the Head of School Discretionary Fund, which she established. Upon her death in 2019, Adah left \$3.5 million to Westtown. This transformational legacy gift funded the Adah R.

Davis Scholarship Fund, the Westtown endowment, and renovations to the Center for the Living Arts.

Adah was an extremely good steward of her assets, which have passed to Westtown where they make a difference in the school and the lives of our students every day. Her life was indeed a life well lived in service to others. Thank you, dear friend!

PROVIDING THE KEY TO A TRANSFORMATIONAL EDUCATION

AT WESTTOWN SCHOOL, our commitment to financial aid goes beyond the spirit of giving and the desire to support others on their journey. Our work to become a need-blind institution as called for in our Strategic Vision may seem a bold aspiration, but it is an intentional step toward creating the community we know we should be.

For nearly half of our 224 year history, our school has leaned towards widening access to our education and our ethos. However, we cannot fairly claim to widen access without also ensuring that Westtown is as accessible as it can be to all families regardless of their means. This is urgent, critical, foundational work for the Quaker calling at the heart of the Westtown mission.

“Every year we turn away students who would be a great match for Westtown because we have more kids needing significant financial aid than we can currently support. We also struggle to achieve the level of socio-economic diversity we would like to achieve in Lower and Middle School for the same reason. The current endowed funds

support only a fraction of the financial aid we provide. The larger the endowed funds, the more students we can say yes to,” said Nathan Bohn ’83, Dean of Enrollment Management.

An endowed fund is a sustainable source of funding for Westtown School. It is our current policy to distribute 4.5% annually (based on the twelve-quarter trailing average market value of the endowment). The principal of the endowment is not distributed. Additional earnings are reinvested in the endowment. As of June 30, 2022, Westtown’s endowment was valued at \$110,710,244.

Westtown seeks to provide a minimum of \$12 million in endowed scholarships and additional financial aid resources to take the first steps toward becoming need blind and work to ensure every student who could benefit from a Westtown education has that opportunity.

“All of the reasons I wanted Westtown for my own children are the reasons I want it for all children,” said a current parent who established an endowed full

scholarship. “The Westtown community is helping us shape who our children will be, and this gift is our recognition of the value we place in that experience for every child.”

Donors who choose to invest in or create a scholarship personally ensure that students can take part in a Westtown education today, regardless of their family’s financial resources. A gift of \$100,000 establishes an endowed scholarship, which covers partial tuition for one student. A gift of \$1,300,000 provides financial aid of almost \$60,000 per year, equivalent to nearly the annual tuition for one Upper School boarding student.

“Through this gift, we get to make an immeasurable difference in the life of a young person, and while that may sound like a platitude, we see that difference in our own children each year. We get to

make Westtown possible for any child,” said the parent, “and sometimes that feels more like a gift to us, than from us.”

Significant philanthropy is required at Westtown to reduce our dependence on tuition revenue and strengthen our ability to maximize access to Westtown. It will take the full support of our community to reach our aspirational goals in perpetuity. This year, alums and current parents helped us meet that challenge in a resounding way, underscoring our collective commitment to making Westtown accessible to all. We thank you and so do our students.

WESTTOWN'S BUDGET



Sanjay Jain, a member of our Board of Trustees, is the Clerk of the Board's Finance Committee, and he also serves on the Executive Committee, the Advancement Committee, the Capital Campaign Committee, and the Committee on Trustees. Sanjay was the Managing Director of Technology and Banking at JP Morgan for more than 26 years, where he divided his time between London, San Francisco, and New York City. He currently works in Technology Investment and Merchant Banking at LionTree LLC. Sanjay and his wife, Heather, are the parents of Logan '22 and Maya '24.

Sanjay agreed to answer a few commonly asked questions about the school's budget.

How does Westtown's operating budget work?

Westtown aims for a break-even budget annually, which means all revenue and expenses net to zero. The Dean of Finance and Operations, in consultation with school leadership, leads a multi-step process to develop the budget from a draft to interim to final. More than 40 budget managers contribute to the process by creating their own department's zero-based budget. This approach allows Westtown to be nimble in understanding expenses, prioritizing resources, and managing the short-term and long-term stability of the school. Consistent with our peer schools, the most significant budget items are tuition revenue and personnel expenses, which serve as the building blocks of our budget.

What are the school's revenue sources?

Tuition is the largest single driver of Westtown's revenue, representing 80% of our overall budget. Secondary revenue sources include contributions from the Westtown community, and revenue from auxiliary programs, such as summer camps and facility rentals. Annual gifts to the Westtown Fund

and EITC also provide funding for the operating budget. Other capital gifts support the endowment, which ensures our long-term ability to withstand unforeseen market changes, such as those caused by the coronavirus pandemic.

What are Westtown's expenses?

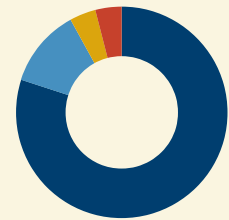
The most important asset of the school is undoubtedly its people: our faculty, staff, coaches, and administrators. Employee compensation, benefits, housing, and professional development are large expenses. The recruitment and retention of skilled professionals has become very competitive in recent years, and labor costs have been rising rapidly in Chester County and beyond. The second most significant expense category is related to the maintenance of our physical plant and campus. We are experiencing rapid cost escalation in almost every budget area, with limited recourse in sight.

What are capital expenditures?

Capital expenditures are funds allocated to build, acquire, upgrade, and maintain physical assets costing more than \$5,000 such as buildings, technology, furniture, and equipment.

How are capital expenditures approved?

Every year, a comprehensive list of possible capital expenditures is compiled by the Director of Facilities. Over several months, the school's administrative team refines and prioritizes the project list. A final list, along with estimated costs, is then presented to the Board of Trustees for approval. Oversight is also provided by the Finance Committee and the Buildings, Grounds, and Environment Committee. Last year, the capital expenditures budget was \$1,200,000, and we are working to increase it.



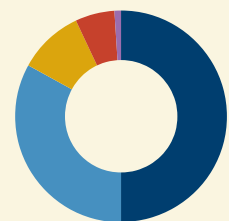

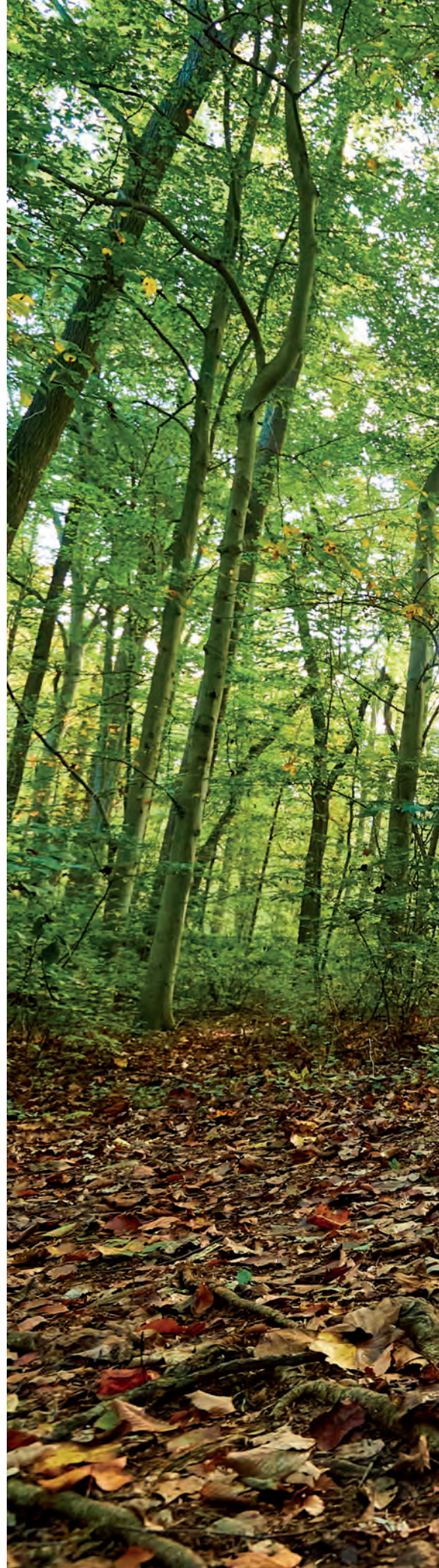

CREATING SPACE

Envisioning a new Center for the Living Arts

AT THE CORE OF A WESTTOWN EDUCATION is a journey of self-discovery and growth. Illuminating each day what was previously obscured or unimagined, coursework and co-curriculars guide students on a personal exploration to seek out and honor that of God in themselves and each other. The arts play a powerful role in this discovery process.

Westtown's Visual and Performing Arts Program is devoted to the education of a new generation of artists who are informed, empowered, collaborative, and empathetic. Through the development of skills in music, dramatic arts, visual arts, and dance, our teachers challenge students to find new ways to reach beyond the borders of what they know, using the arts as a lens for understanding the world in an empathetic manner. The skills they



develop will serve them in all facets of life: exploring shared histories and diverse cultures, listening to others, delivering and accepting critique, taking risks, approaching life with curiosity, problem-solving, and using failure as a step towards growth.

Today, a visit to the Center for the Living Arts (CLA) demonstrates the key role the arts play at Westtown. A three-phase renewal of the building supports the potential of our academic and co-curricular programs. The call to revitalize the center also speaks to the very beliefs and ethos of our community.

Since 2019, we have:

- revitalized rehearsal spaces for instrumental and choral music;
- opened a vibrant new green room and dressing rooms for theater productions;
- constructed new, state-of-the-art music practice rooms;
- created bright, airy visual arts classrooms to inspire our young artists;
- installed new wall coverings throughout the theater that sharpen acoustics;
- added HVAC to allow for proper instrument tuning; and,
- built safe catwalks that allow student learners to participate in technical work.

The third and final phase will be the largest undertaking in the renovation.

This phase includes an exciting addition, replacing unused space with a stunning gallery, flex performance space, a student collaboration space, and a common gathering area. Alongside critical modifications for accessibility and an aesthetic upgrade of the building’s façade and the theater vestibule, the fully renewed center will take advantage of one of the most beautiful vistas on the Westtown campus, tying the community together around the arts.

Two alums recently expressed their enthusiasm and support for the arts at Westtown with inspiring and transformative gifts in support of the CLA project. Each motivated by different elements of their journey at Westtown, both donors took a moment to describe the reasons they had for making their gifts, and for making them now.

Currently based in Hong Kong, Jehan Chu '94 arrived at Westtown from New Jersey, and was an Upper School boarding student for two years. His sister, Shamsi Chu Gravel, graduated from Westtown in 1990. During a March 2022 visit with Westtown students and faculty over Zoom, Jehan expressed gratitude for his Westtown education and recalled spending time in the photography lab and the Arts Center — both experiences that offered opportunities to learn about photography and art from fellow

students and faculty, which inspired his future career.

After graduating from Westtown, Jehan earned a degree in International Relations from Johns Hopkins University and began his career in New York City at an internet startup. After working for Sotheby’s in Hong Kong, he became an art advisor, helping collectors build contemporary art collections and supporting local arts organizations. In 2013, he began investing in Bitcoin and building the crypto community in Asia and eventually founded Kenetic, a blockchain venture capital firm based in Hong Kong and Puerto Rico. He continues to collect art and NFTs (non-fungible tokens) and support organizations at the intersection of art and technology.

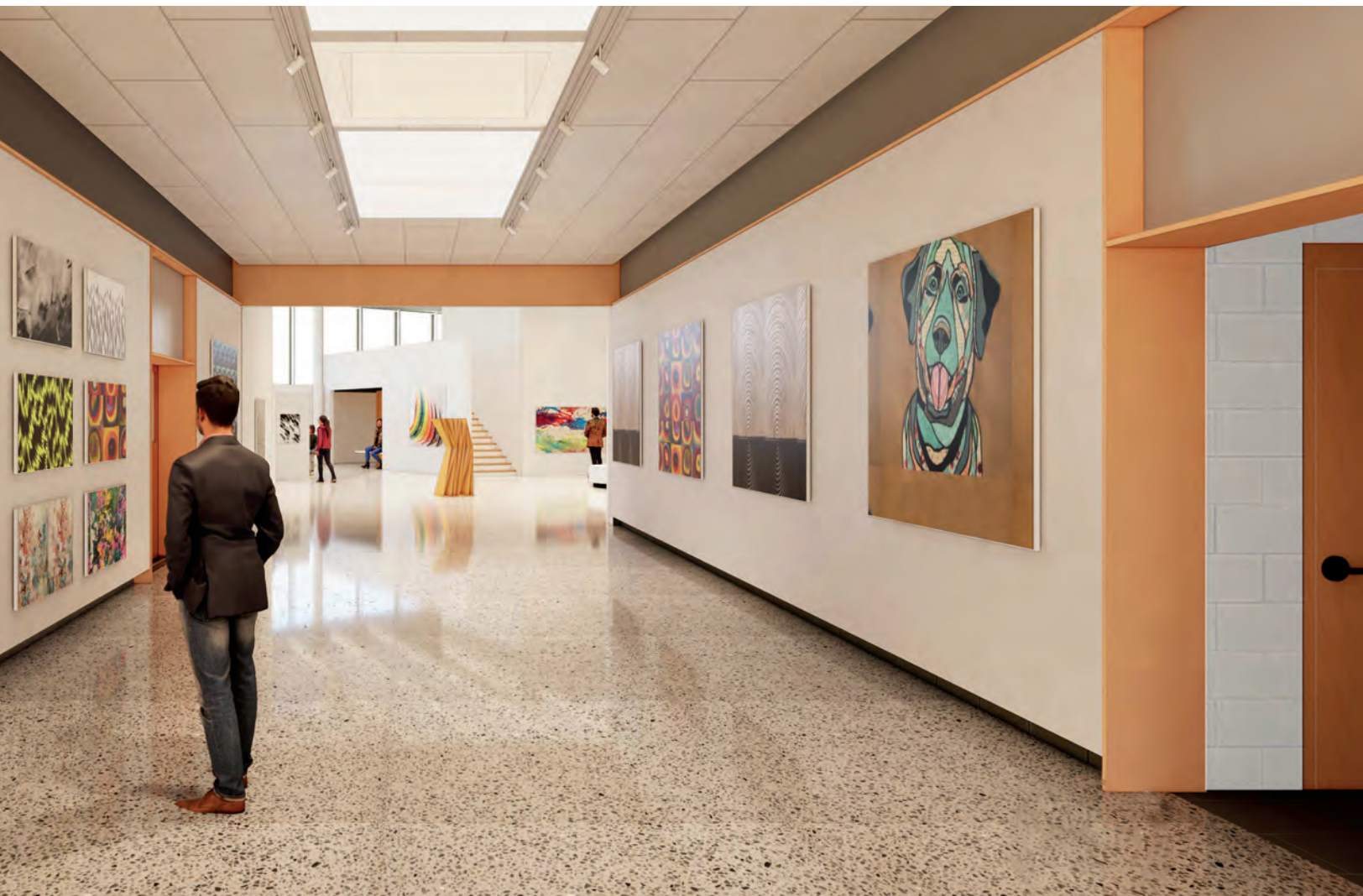
In April of 2022, Jehan made a transformational anchor pledge enabling the renovation of the CLA. In honor of his gift, the new two-story exhibition gallery, which will display acquired collections and visiting artists’ installations, will be named for Jehan and his family. Jehan will also lend his considerable expertise to assist in the development of our art collection and the design of the gallery space to best suit our vision for the space.

Will Hildreth '81, began at Westtown in fourth grade. As a boy, Will spent many afternoons at the Living Arts in Philadelphia where his father, Daniel, was an actor, and he loved the exploration process of watching productions go from being a vision to a finished project. While his love for the theater and the arts began there, it was nourished at Westtown. Will recalls numerous experiences, from Lower School through his days on the catwalk in the theater for Upper School productions, as instrumental in further kindling his interest in the arts. Specifically, he shared memories of the new theater director at the time, Spencer Gates, who allowed him



first-hand experience that highlighted how valuable the physical plant is to arts education and to student learners.

“When I learned that this project was happening, I was so excited because I understood the value it would immediately bring to the student experience,” said Will. “My time at Westtown was really transformational for me. Having the breathing room to really explore different things and see where my interest lay is Westtown’s way, and that is, in some ways, I think, completely unique in the educational world. That is why I wanted to give back, and it is particularly exciting that it was around the arts and around revitalizing the building that was so important to me when I was there at school.”

Through a challenge grant from the Daniel W. Dietrich II Foundation, Will and his family have made a substantial pledge to name The Hildreth-Dietrich

Visual Arts Wing. The wing will create a formal visual arts space within the CLA, providing an open, collaborative area for student work, critique and displaying, as well as housing the sculpture studio, digital lab, and the drawing studio. Serving as the hub for teaching and learning the visual arts at Westtown, the wing will prioritize student-curated exhibitions and work and will place a meaningful spotlight on the final exhibition of the year for our community, the Senior Art Show.

“I think my dad would be excited that we are able to make this gift now. He knew how much Westtown meant to me, to our family really, and this is also right in line with what the foundation supports—visual arts and arts education,” said Will. “This gift, like so much of the grantmaking he did, is about letting kids explore their creative process and giving them a chance to just reach for something without knowing

what the outcome will be. That, I think, is what arts education is about.”

Dean of Faculty and Innovation Chris Wills adds, “These tremendous investments in our program allow us the opportunity to thoughtfully expand our space so that it can come to life with performances, exhibits, learning opportunities, and all forms of creative expression that are representative of the depth and breadth of talent our students and faculty possess. We now look forward to securing the additional gifts required to complete the transformation of the CLA. We are all eager to engage the entire Westtown community, and our visitors, in our new visual and performing arts home.”
