Dear Friends,

One of the joys of my job is the privilege of bearing witness, every day, to the wonder that is Westtown School. I watch giggling four-year-olds roll down grassy slopes in the shadow of a dormitory where teenagers form lifelong friendships with peers whose homes and families are half a world away. I watch our youngest children learn to read their first words and our oldest vigorously pursue sophisticated intellectual passions. I watch our adults dedicate their lives to our students, helping them learn to live together in an intentional community, listening for the still small voice in themselves, seeking the Light in each other, and knowing they all belong here at Westtown.

None of this beautiful experiment is possible without the profound generosity of our donors, whose many gifts provide us with the financial capacity to offer this astonishing Westtown education. Between July 1, 2022 and June 30, 2023, 1,665 Westonians made gifts totaling more than \$9.7 million, nearly \$2 million ahead of our five-year average. These gifts supported financial aid for students, our beloved campus and program, professional development for faculty, capital projects, and our endowment.

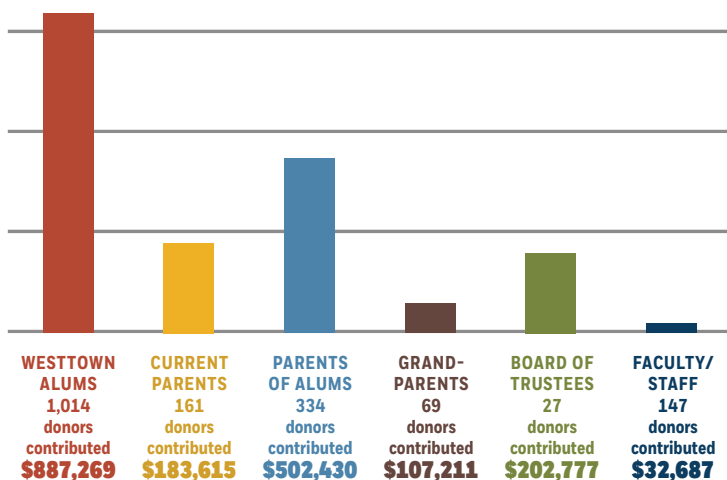

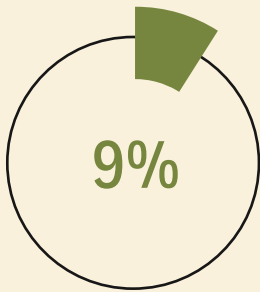
Gifts by Constituency



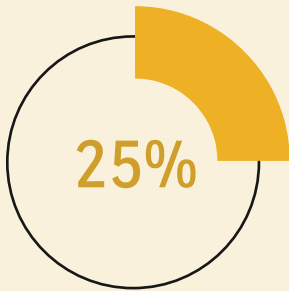

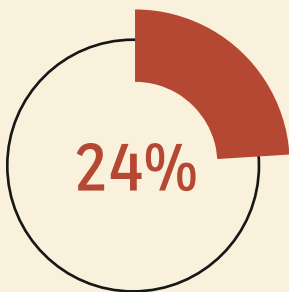




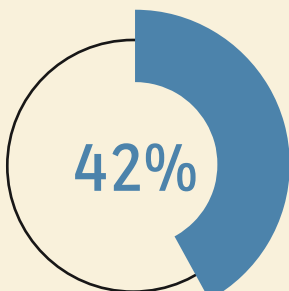

INSURING A LEGACY



Barry Hogenauer '73 and Mary Sommer '73

As the youngest of five faculty children, Barry Hogenauer '73 grew up on Westtown's campus with his siblings Alice "Kim" '57, Dan '59, Margaret '61, and Sam '64. Their father, Eugene "Gene" Hogenauer, taught German and Latin and coached tennis for 23 years at Westtown. Their mother, Mary Owsley Hogenauer, tutored Westtown students and served on the school's History and Relics Committee (a precursor to our current Archives).

In 1991, the five Hogenauer children decided to establish an endowed fund to honor their parents' service to and love of Westtown. As they considered the purpose of the fund, Barry recalled that during his senior year, several of his classmates—like him, the children of faculty and staff who had attended Westtown since Lower School—were no longer there. Even with partial tuition remission, the families could not afford to keep their children at Westtown. With this in mind, the family decided that The Eugene and Mary Owsley Hogenauer Fund would provide financial aid to the children of Westtown employees, with priority given to the children of non-teaching staff. Over the years, it has done exactly that.

Thirty years later, as Barry approached his 50th reunion, he wanted to jumpstart his class's fundraising efforts. He donated two life insurance policies to the school—policies he had taken out many years earlier and the premiums for which were now being paid by the earnings on the principal. One of the policies will be added to The Eugene and Mary Owsley Hogenauer Fund to ensure the fund continues to grow. The other is designated to The Class of 1973 Endowed Scholarship Fund, which was established by a challenge gift of \$50,000 from James and Frances (Twink) Wood (parents of Emily Wood Crofoot '73). Members of the Class of 1973 surpassed that challenge with their own gifts, thereby exceeding the threshold of \$100,000 required to create an endowed fund.

Barry is pleased that these life insurance policies—and their leveraged value—will benefit future generations of Westtown students, while also honoring his parents and his classmates. "Westtown is my foundation," he says. "All that I have achieved in my life, I owe to my parents and my upbringing on the Westtown campus."

NOURISHING OUR COMMUNITY

Meals at Westtown have always been about much more than nutritional sustenance. They have also been about building community, sharing experiences, and growing connections. In our current Dining Room and kitchen, food is prepared and served in ways that honor our essential Quaker values of community and service. Every week, our Dining Services team prepares more than 7,500 meals and 4,200 snacks for the entire school community.

Over the years, Westtown's program, schedule, and population have evolved and grown in ways that hinder the shared dining experience to which we are committed. The size and configuration of the Dining

Room no longer align with the needs of our Middle and Upper Schools, our Dining Services staff is challenged to shoehorn their excellent work into a space that was designed for a very different era, and students and adults daily encounter a degree of traffic that significantly diminishes the community dining experience.

Several years ago, a committee of faculty, staff, students, administrators, trustees, and alums (skillfully co-chaired by Director of Dining Services Beth Pellegrino and Trustee Charlotte Triefus) was convened to discern a way forward. It quickly became clear that a redesign must center on connection, reflection, warmth, and

simplicity. Furthermore, it became evident that construction of a new free-standing space was needed.

Factors leading to this decision included the prohibitive expense of renovating our outdated spaces and the inevitable disruption to the Middle and Upper Schools throughout the construction process. With the thoughtful relocation of dining to a nearby site on campus, the old Dining Room will provide 3,000 square feet of flexible programmatic space in the heart of the Main Building; a detail not to be overlooked.

"We are grateful to have partnered with SHoP Architects, a renowned firm in New York City whose founding principals



Bill Sharples '83, Chris Sharples '83, and Corie Sharples know Westtown well," said Head of School Chris Benbow '90. "In addition to Chris and Bill's long relationship with the school as alums, Corie and Bill are also the parents of a current Upper School student. The Sharples' deep understanding of this community has been essential in helping us imagine the possibilities in this exciting work."

The new free-standing dining room and kitchen, just across from Central on the north side of the Main Building, will enable the entire Upper School (both students and adults) to enjoy meals at the same time; building community and removing

constraints from their daily schedules. Our Dining Services team will have access to facilities needed to accommodate the variety of dietary needs of our students, while aspiring to the highest standards of sustainable practices. Additionally, the location of the new dining room and kitchen will provide much-needed accessible space for gatherings, celebrations, and meetings all year round.

"Food and nutrition are central to learning and central to our community," said Beth. "Living together in community means planning, preparing, and eating meals together. The new dining room and kitchen will not only be planned

intentionally to highlight our Work Program and local and sustainable food initiatives, but it will also open up a new way to connect with our beautiful campus. Creating a welcoming, communal space will promote wellness for the kitchen team, students, faculty, and staff."

The project will be funded through a combination of existing school resources and philanthropy, and we are deeply appreciative of those donors who have already made financial commitments. CARING FOR WESTTOWN'S 600-ACRES

Emily Temple Abels '07, a member of our Board of Trustees, is the Clerk of the Board's Buildings, Grounds, and Environment Committee, and she also serves on the Board's Farmland Task Force Committee. Emily is an attorney at Larmore Scarlett, LLP, where she focuses on estate planning and estate administration. Prior to joining Larmore Scarlett, Emily spent four years in Philadelphia as a child advocate attorney. Emily lives with her wife and son in Kennett Square, Pennsylvania. Emily was excited to answer a few questions about the work of the Board's Buildings, Grounds, and Environment Committee.

What is the charge of the Buildings, Grounds, and Environment Committee?

The Buildings, Grounds, and Environment Committee ensures that the school's campus and capital assets are managed in accordance with its mission, policies, procedures, and good operating practices.

What types of projects does the committee address?

The committee receives updates and provides feedback on large capital projects, including renovations and new construction, as well as smaller capital projects that are budgeted on an annual basis. The school's major project categories include security-related equipment, information technology equipment, program-specific enhancements, campus housing improvements, vehicles, and general maintenance. The committee also oversees project design and

budgets to ensure that school resources are being managed appropriately.

How are projects prioritized?

Large capital projects are prioritized by school leadership. Current projects include: the Center for the Living Arts (phase 3), the Oak Lane Turf Fields project, the Lower School Playground, and the Dining Room project. The Head of School, the Dean of Finance and Operations, and the Director of Facilities collaborate annually with division leaders to prioritize smaller capital projects. Various factors are considered in prioritizing these smaller projects, including health and safety, program needs, and urgency. Our committee receives updates about the school's various projects throughout the year.

How many employees maintain the school's buildings and grounds?

The facilities team has twenty-seven employees, including mechanical trades specialists, a grounds crew, and housekeeping staff. In addition to our employees, the school outsources some mowing, as well as some nighttime and weekend housekeeping.

Why do you enjoy working with this committee?

The scope of the committee's work is wonderfully broad. We consider complex long-term projects as well as all of the critical details to maximize our overall sustainability and accessibility goals. The projects which come before the committee focus on improving, updating, and optimizing our spaces and experiences. I love being a part of a group that is always looking to the future and planning ahead with the goal of supporting Westtown's growing and thriving community. Best of all, the projects produce visible results. It is such a pleasure to see how the work of the committee has a positive impact on the campus and all who use it.
